

PAPER BAG PORTFOLIO INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS

1. Handle paper grocery bags (Whole Foods or Lunardi's are best – Trader Joe's bags work, but are a bit too small for some projects).
2. Packing tape (clear works best).
3. Scissors

Step 1 -- Open up the grocery bag and stand it up. Cut down one end (one of the smaller ends where the bag bends when folded) from top to bottom.

Step 2 -- Cut out the entire flat bottom section of the bag and discard.

Step 3 -- Take the remaining bag and flatten it like a portfolio with the handles lined up together. The cut side should line up, as should the bottom. Tape down the side and along the bottom.
