E-mail to principals regarding assignment of CBOC members to specific schools.

As you know, Measure F was passed under the provisions of Proposition 39 which require that the district have a Citizens Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC).

Our CBOC has assigned each member to a number of schools for the purposes of communication and liaison. The list below indicates the schools to which the CBOC members have been assigned.

I'm sharing this information with you because you may hear from the CBOC member now and then. Please welcome them if they should call, but remember, the charge of the CBOC is "to review and report as to whether the San José Unified School District is spending 2002 Measure F bond money only on the 'specific facilities projects' listed in the ballot measure". It is the role of the Board of Education to make decisions about Measure F priorities within the parameters of voter authority.
