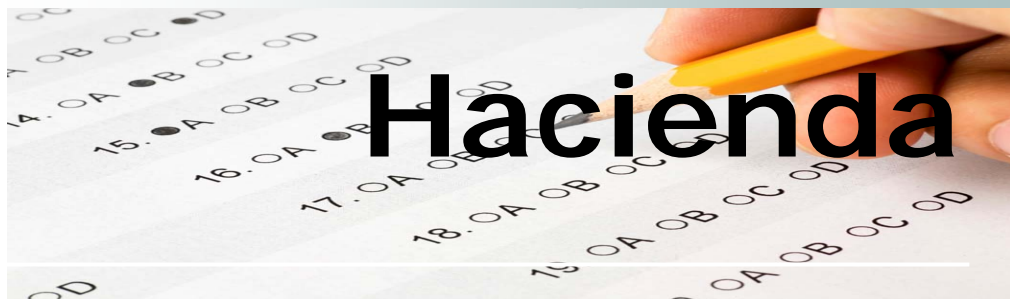

## Facilities

Results of a facility inspection conducted on 9/11/08 rated this school’s condition as **GOOD.**

The Hacienda Environmental Science Magnet is 41 years old. In recent years, our media center/computer lab was established with major restoration to part of the school. School modernization took place during the 1998-99 school year. An upper grade play equipment structure was added by parent contributions in the fall of 2000. These projects were completed to provide a safe and

comfortable environment for learning. Hacienda continues to be under construction, which is slated to be finished in the 2008-09 school year. PreK-2 will have new classrooms, and the whole school will enjoy a new library, computer lab, music room, as well as a new science lab and classroom strategically located next to the outdoor classroom. Upper grade classrooms and

office modernization took place during the summer of the 06-07 school year, with current classrooms receiving updated cabinetry and windows, and the cafeteria / multipurpose room getting a makeover. School grounds are kept clean and well maintained by our custodial and grounds keeping staff. The school also has a detailed Emergency Preparedness Plan and Beautification Plan.
