Facilities

Allen at Steinbeck K-8 School is in its fifth year on the site of Steinbeck Middle School, which closed in June of 2005. The Allen at Steinbeck K-8 School enrollment is 845 students. The facilities include 44 classrooms, a Media Center, a Computer Lab, two mobile computer labs, Speech & Language Rooms, and ELD/Reading Room, RSP

Resource rooms, and a Science center with an Art Vista Room.

The school incorporates into its yearly schedule periodic fire and disaster drills in addition to campus-wide emergency plans and a close working relationship with local law enforcement agencies and neighboring schools.
