

## Most Frequently Asked Enrollment Questions

1. Do I have to schedule an appointment to enroll my child or can I just walk-in?  
*You can just walk in and/or also make an appointment by calling (408) 535-6412*
2. Once I'm at the enrollment center, how long will it take to get my child enrolled?  
*A regular enrollment should take about 30 minutes.*
3. Will my child be able to start school the same day that I enroll him/her?  
*No, the Enrollment Center needs to inform the school that student is coming and the school needs to prepare for student. Start date is always next day.*
4. Now that my child is enrolled in school; when will he/she be able to start riding the bus?  
*After start of school: Seven school days from the date the application was completed. For more information regarding transportation, please visit SJUSD website, under "Transportation Information"*
5. What is the cut-off date for enrolling my child for Kindergarten because of birth date?  
*Student has to be born on or before Dec 02, 2004 for this school year (2009) and on or before Dec 02, 2005 for next school year (2010).*
6. When does enrollment start for next years' Kindergarteners?  
*Pre-registration will start April 01, 2010. For additional information regarding enrollment time line, please visit SJUSD website, under "Pre-registration date".*
7. How do I find out what and where my neighborhood school is?  
*You can call the Enrollment Center at (408) 535-6412 or you may go onto the district website [SJUSD.org](http://SJUSD.org), under **school locator**. If address is not within SJUSD. You can also find your home school district of resident at [WWW.eservices.sccgov.org](http://WWW.eservices.sccgov.org)*

8. Can I have some of the required documents faxed to you from the previous school?  
*Yes, Immunizations record, birth certificate, student's Individualize Education Plan (IEP) and transcripts for secondary students can be fax to Enrollment Center at (408) 535-2345.*
9. Can the enrollment process be started now, and I get the TB test done next week?  
*TB Mantoux test results must be completed at time of enrollment (Santa Clara County School TB mandate).*
10. What is the difference between Intra-District and Inter-District Transfers?  
***Intra** is a transfer within San Jose Unified School District from one school to another school.*  
***Inter** is a transfer from one school district to another school district.*
