

DRESS & UNIFORM POLICY
All Bachrodt Students are required to wear school uniforms.

Rationale:

The Bachrodt School Community believes that school uniforms create a safer and more orderly environment, one that fosters a sense of belonging and instills high standards of academic performance.

Uniform Colors:

- ◆ Tops/Polo - White, light blue, Navy or Grey
- ◆ Bottoms - Navy Blue

Tops - Any or all of the following are acceptable:

- ◆ Polo shirt
- ◆ Turtleneck
- ◆ White blouse or shirt with a collar
- ◆ Hats are not allowed.
- ◆ All shirts must have collars, except for school sponsored T-shirts

Bottoms - Any of the following are acceptable:

- ◆ Navy blue slack pants
- ◆ Navy blue walking shorts (appropriate length)
- ◆ Solid navy blue jumper

Special Notes

- 🍏 All shirts must be tucked in.
- 🍏 No sagging of pants
- 🍏 Hats are not allowed
- 🍏 All pants must be worn to fit at the waist.
- 🍏 Baggy pants, jeans, and warm-up suits are not allowed.
- 🍏 Color options for tights and socks: Navy blue, grey, or white.
- 🍏 Heele's or any other type of shoes with wheels are prohibited.
- 🍏 Tank tops are not allowed.
- 🍏 Sleeveless tops are not allowed

IMPORTANT: A letter will be sent home the 1st time a student comes to school out of uniform. The second time will require a parent to bring required clothing to school before the student is admitted to class. The third incident will result in an in-school suspension, and a parent conference with the principal.
