DRESS & UNIFORM POLICY
All Bachrodt Students are required to wear school uniforms.

Rationale:

The Bachrodt School Community believes that school uniforms create a safer and more orderly environment, one that fosters a sense of belonging and instills high standards of academic performance. Please help the school to maintain an appropriate school climate by making sure that your child is in uniform each and every day.

Uniform Colors:

Tops/Polo – Navy, White, light blue
Bottoms - Navy Blue

Tops –

Any or all of the following are acceptable:

Polo shirt
All shirts must have collars, except for school sponsored T-shirts (that can be work Friday)
White blouse or shirt with a collar
Turtle neck

Bottoms - Any of the following are acceptable

Navy blue slack pants or skirts
Navy blue walking shorts (knee length)
Solid navy blue jumper

Special Notes

All shirts must be tucked in.
All pants must be worn to fit at the waist.
Color options for tights and socks: Navy blue, or white
No flip flops or open toe shoes

NOT Allowed

Tank tops and sleeve less tops
No sagging of pants
Heele's or any other type of shoes with wheels
Baggy pants, jeans, and warm-up suits
Navy blue beanies may be worn outside during winter.
No Make-up
No hats

Monday Uniforms – To set the academic tone for the week students are to wear, if purchased, the new Bachrodt Charter Academy polo shirt, or the regular uniform shirt.

Friday Uniform – Fridays will be College Spirit Day so wear a college t-shirt. (A Bachrodt t-shirt may also be worn to celebrate this spirit day.)

IMPORTANT: A letter will be sent home the 1st time a student comes to school out of uniform. The second time will require a parent to bring required clothing to school before the student is admitted to class. The third incident will result in an in-school suspension, and a parent conference with the principal. Please support our school policy.
