Student Dress Uniform Policy 2011-2012

BACKGROUND

CASTILLERO MIDDLE SCHOOL became a uniform school in September of 1994. Since its introduction, parents and staff have noticed improved conduct, academic focus, and camaraderie on campus. The dress/uniform policy is reviewed each school year with students and parents and is approved by the School Site Council. Your support is necessary for the continued success of this policy.

The uniform policy indicates what students are to wear. It cannot possibly list what is not to be worn. In general, students can assume that if an article of clothing is considered to be outerwear, and it is not on this list, it is not allowed on campus.

NEW FOR 2011-2012

- ◊ **Solid Gray skirts will be added to the policy. Plaid skirts may be worn only for the school years of 2011-2012 (7th and 8th grade only) and 2012-2013 (8th grade only).**

THE FUNDAMENTALS

Students will attend school each day in uniform which consists of a white, black, forest green, or uniform gray polo shirt, a school logo T-shirt, turtleneck or mock turtleneck, uniform gray shorts or pants with belt, or uniform gray skirt or skort. It is the student's responsibility to have the uniform ready to wear each day. Look-alike clothing that conforms to the uniform policy may be purchased.

PURCHASING INFORMATION

Should a family choose not to purchase the official school uniform, look-alike clothing that conforms to the uniform policy may be purchased at other stores, such as Kohl's, and San Jose Blue Jeans. More information is located in the Castillero Uniform Shopping Guidelines form enclosed in the August packet.

GUIDELINES

- Blue and/or red are not to be worn anywhere, including on scrunchies, jewelry, key chains, shoes (including soles, trim, laces, and accents), knickknacks, backpacks, etc.
- Clothing will be free from stickers, drawings, decals, etc.
- Backpacks and uniforms must be free from ALL graffiti and stickers that were not placed by the manufacturer.
- All clothing will be size appropriate for the student. Tight, spandex pants, baggy pants, saggy pants, pants that slide past the hips and expose one's undergarment are not allowed

CONSEQUENCE

When a student has 3 minor uniform violations:

- Parents will be called to inform them of the uniform violation
- Student will receive one afterschool detention

When a student has a major uniform violation:

- Parents will be notified immediately and expected to bring an appropriate uniform
- If this is impossible a loaner will be provided for the day
