



UNIFORM POLICY • 2011-12

Ernesto Galarza Elementary School Hammer Montessori @ Galarza

- *Galarza and Hammer are uniform schools---all students must be dressed in the approved school uniform each day. If a student is not in uniform, either the parent will be called to bring a uniform or the student will change into a uniform borrowed from the school.*
- *Uniforms must be neat and clean, and shirts must be tucked in at all times.*
- *Uniforms may be purchased at the store of your choice, providing they meet the following guidelines.*

The Galarza/Hammer school uniform consists of the following options:

Navy Blue Skirts, Jumpers and Skorts: Girls' navy chino or polyester skirts, jumpers and skorts should be knee-length and plain (*without added decoration*).

Navy Blue Long Pants and Knee-length Shorts: Girls' and boys' plain chino navy pants and knee-length shorts must be the appropriate size, and have belt loops and two side pockets (*no baggies, logos, short shorts or cargo pants*). Pants/shorts must be worn with the shirt tucked in. Dark solid color belts are optional.



Plaid skirts and jumpers: Girls' skirts and jumpers in "Hastings Plaid" can be purchased from Merry Mart (*call 296-0423 for information*).

White Blouses: Girls' white blouses must be a "Peter Pan" tuck-in style.

Polo Shirts: Girls' and boys' short-sleeved or long-sleeved polo shirts may be white or light blue.

Long-sleeved Turtleneck or Mock-turtleneck Shirts: In colder weather, plain long-sleeved turtleneck or mock-turtleneck shirts are acceptable in white or light blue.

Sweatshirts and Sweaters: Students may wear plain navy blue sweatshirts or sweaters in the classroom and on the playground.

Shoes: Athletic shoes are recommended. Sandals, high-heels, wheeled and musical shoes are not acceptable.



Socks and Tights: Socks, tights and shorts worn under skirts are to be plain black, navy or white. (*Please note that leggings may not be worn as part of the school uniform.*)

Coats and Jackets: Students may wear coats or jackets of their choice while out on the playground. Please note that coats/jackets may *not* be worn in the classroom (*plain navy blue sweatshirts or sweaters may be worn in the classroom*). ***Please be sure to label all outerwear with your child's name, so that misplaced clothing can be easily returned to the student.***

Hats/Caps/Head Coverings: Hats, caps and other head coverings are not permitted, except during approved activities or for documented religious or medical reasons. Sun-protective hats may be worn outdoors only. (*A sun-protective hat has a brim large enough to protect the face, back of neck and ears.*) Authorization from a parent or doctor is required for a student to wear a sun-protective hat.
