State of the Art Science Complex**

**San Jose, CA.** Abraham Lincoln students and teachers will soon be enjoying state of the art science classrooms. Groundbreaking ceremonies will be held on November 27, 2007.

**Who:** Superintendent Don Iglesias, Board of Education Trustee Rich Garcia, District 6 Councilmember Pierluigi Oliverio, Lincoln Foundation President Janet Akins-James, Steve Corchado, CM, Kitchell Construction Management, Bill Gould, BFGC, Jackie Zeller, Principal Lincoln High School.

**What:** Groundbreaking ceremony for the 7,000 sq.' state of the art science center for Abraham Lincoln High School.

**Where:** Lincoln High School, 555 Dana Ave. San Jose, 95126. The ceremony will take place towards the rear of the school near the media center. The closest cross streets are Brooklyn Ave. & Garden Dr.

**When:** November 27, 2007 at 3:30 p.m.

**Why:** Abraham Lincoln is starting construction on four state of the art science labs that include shared prep space and a conference room. These labs will be equipped with gas, water, fume hoods, overhead projectors and other advanced technological features. The architectural features will complement those of Lincoln's newly completed theatre. The \$4 M project is expected to be completed by the opening of school '08.
