

Program Strand Eligibility

Eligibility for the program strand assignment priority:

- 1 District students who have participated in an identified District program strand, who do not live within the attendance boundary of the next school (grade level) providing the curriculum for the program and who did not receive their first choice school through the Secondary Choices Assignment Process. All students need to complete the Choices School Request Form in order to be eligible for consideration for the Program Strand Option.
- 2 District students who have for each year of enrollment in the District, enrolled in at least one course per semester identified as part of the program strand.

Note: Non- District students are not eligible for the program strand assignment priority.

The program strand assignment priority will only be consider after the following priority students have been assigned to their 1st choice school:

- Priority 1. Students who reside in the school attendance boundary.
- Priority 2. Students who are requesting a Voluntary Integrative Transfer.
- Priority 3. Students with a sibling who is currently attending the school and who will continue to be enrolled the following year.

Prior to the assigning the *4th priority students, the Director of Student Assignment will assign those students who have meet requirements for the program strand assignment priority. Be advised transportation services will not be provided by San Jose Unified School District based on this program strand assignment.

This request application must be submitted to the current school for review and verification of courses taken by the student. A copy of the student's transcript needs to be attached to this application.

Time Line:

February 1, 2010 to March 26, 2010

Parents submit the Program Strand Request Application to their student's current Middle School of attendance.

February 2, 2010 to March 31, 2010

Schools submit received request application and required transcript to Bob Gonzales, Director of Student Assignment.

April 5, 2010 to April 5, 2010

Parents will be notified by Student Assignment of the approval or denial of the request.
