Advisory Guidelines

One of the main features of our Modified Block is the Advisory Period. Advisory is concentrated study time for students as well as office hours for all teachers. Students will now have built-in time to speak to teachers for additional help as well as make up assignments and tests. The following are guidelines that all students and teachers will follow:

- Teachers are assigned to their main classroom-place on your syllabus.
- All students will sign-in at the location they go for Advisory.
- Students who have a D or F in one or more subjects will be placed on contract and required to attend said class.
- No in/out privileges-When a student enters a classroom, they are to stay in the classroom for the entire period.
- Media Center-open for math tutoring, research or private studying (limited seating)
- Students may be required to attend AP advisory...(multiple AP classes must be worked out).
- Grade level advisors will be available for drop in counseling.
(Mon/Thur -9th/10th)
(Wed/Fri-11th/12th)
- If a classroom is filled, student will need to go to the small gym.
- Any student not in a classroom, Media Center, Career Center, will be assigned to the small gym.
- Students may not go to the bank, Student Services or hang out in the main building, quad, basketball courts, etc..
