- May 9** **Senior Readiness Day.** All graduation requirements must be completed/submitted by 4:00PM for seniors to be eligible to participate in graduation activities. Requirements include community service hours, Safety/1st Aid certification, Health and Algebra Certification, Saturday School/AIM, and debts.
- May 9** **Sign-ups begin for graduation speech auditions.** Main office. Last day to sign up is May 18. Speech guidelines are available online or in the main office.
- May 12** **Prom.** Hayes Mansion, dinner included. 6:00-7:00 check-in & photos, 7:00-8:00 dinner, 8:00-11:00 dancing. No reserved seating. Must have current ID to enter. Dance ticket is not required for entrance. Free parking. All participants must arrive no later than 7:00PM.
- May 22** **Graduation speech auditions.** Beginning at 2:45, P102.
- May 25** **Senior Sunset event.** Football field. Time TBD.
- May 30** **Senior Finals: Periods 2, 4, 6.** This is a regular, block-schedule day.
- May 31** **Senior Finals: Periods 1, 3, 5.** This is a regular, block-schedule day.
- May 31** **Senior Awards Night.** Award recipients will be personally notified. 6:00 – 9:00 pm.
- June 1** **Farewell Rally.** This is a rally bell schedule day.
- June 4** **Senior Breakfast.** 8:30 am -10:00 am.
- Mandatory Graduation Rehearsal #1.** WGHS Football stadium. 10:00 am -12:00 pm.
- Students who do not attend this rehearsal **WILL NOT** participate in Graduation. Please reschedule any medical appointments, work schedules, etc.
- June 5** **Mandatory Graduation Rehearsal #2.** WGHS Football stadium. 9:30 am -11:30 pm.
- Students who do not attend this rehearsal **WILL NOT** participate in Graduation. Please reschedule any medical appointments, work schedules, etc.

- Graduates must enter through Garden Street Gate only. Students must **carry** their cap and gown through the gate to gathering area. Students may not bring anything with them; no sunglasses, purses, or cell phones. Caps and gowns may not be altered in any way; no flowers, leis, tape etc. until after the ceremony.
- Students must dress appropriately; gentlemen are to wear collared shirts and slacks. Ladies are to wear dressy attire. No jeans. Footwear must be appropriate for a distinguished event. No tennis shoes or beach-type flip-flops allowed. Procession will be on grass. Wear shoes that won't make you trip or sink into the lawn.
- Behavior on stage is to be respectful. Throwing anything is prohibited. Inappropriate behavior will result in your diploma being withheld until consequences such as Community Service/Sat School are fulfilled.
- Diplomas will not be distributed at the Rose Garden following the graduation. Graduates may pick up diplomas at WGHS Registrar's Office in R 107 beginning June 7.
- Remind your guests they are not allowed to save seats or use any type of artificial noise maker.
- Dana Street gate (near roses) is off limits.
