Frequently Asked Questions

What is the difference between Encore and Applause Choir?

Encore choir is a beginning vocal class. Applause Choir is an advanced vocal class that requires an audition.

What is the difference between Concert Band and Symphonic Band?

Concert band is for true beginners who have had little to no experience playing an instrument (0-6 months). Symphonic Band is for students who are considered intermediate-advanced players or have at least six months experience playing an instrument.

What if I am in the Wheel elective and I already speak Spanish or French?

Keep in mind that there are 6-rotations in the Wheel class. Students may select year-long electives in place of the Wheel elective.

What will my schedule include if I am in the Two-Way Bilingual Immersions (TWBI) Program?

TWBI students' schedules will include: Language Arts, Social Studies, Spanish Language Arts, Science, Math, and PE.

When will I receive my schedule?

Student schedules are distributed 2-3 days before the start of the 2018-19 school year. Our summer mailer will include more specifics. 6th grade students will be invited to attend an orientation (Where Everyone Belongs (WEB) Day to get acquainted with other 6th grade students and the school campus.

What if I don't get the courses I selected?

At the end of the first day of school, students can request a Schedule Change Request form from the main office. Students who do not receive their first choice will be placed on a wait list for the course. As student requests are processed spaces may open for possible schedule changes.

Math Placement Information –

Math placement is based on a student's Unit Assessment scores in 5th grade and any other summative scores administered and available for our site use (State Testing & District Tests). If a student is new to the district and does not have any scores available, the student will be placed in the standard Math 6 class and evaluated for an alternate placement within the first few weeks of school.
